



Current Offerings Available to Families

The governor's office has confirmed that all funeral homes should follow the guidelines for religious facilities.

As of June 26, 2020

Funeral Home Gatherings

Events held in our funeral homes are limited to 50% of our capacity or 1 person per 100 square feet. This restriction limits us to gatherings of 60-75 people at both locations.

Visitation

Families are now permitted to hold public visitation. We request that masks are worn while in the building and we will only allow 60-75 individuals inside at any given time.

Funerals & Memorials

We can now offer public services if attendance is expected to be below 75 people. If more than 75 is anticipated, funerals & memorials must be held outside, or will need to be private or by invitation only.

Church Services

Churches are permitted to hold services and are limited to 50% of their capacity, or a maximum of 75 people.

Outdoor Gatherings

Events held outside have a limit of 150 people. Social distancing must still take place. Outdoor events can take place in a cemetery, or at either of our locations. Both Kidder Memorial Home and Spears Funeral Home have easily accessible lawn space that could accommodate 150 guests. We provide water, parking, facilities, audio equipment, and limited seating for the event.

We have had very good feedback with our outdoors services, in fact, we will continue to offer them after all restrictions are lifted.
